



APPLICATIONS



A home filled with textiles, art and antiques, there was no doubt in my mind we had to make this room speak the language already defined for the rest of the house. A cloak room, not just a powder room. With vintage coats beautifully framed in a box they become art installation. An old carved wood panel adorns the vanity. The entire process of designing this room started when my client fell in love with these tiles from FCML. Designed by Pero these tiles are inspired by geometric patterns seen in Indian textiles from Andhara Pradesh called Telia Rumal.



These tiles bring the look of historic ikat fabric styles to ceramic tiles in eclectic wall and floor tile patterns. The motifs used in this collection have been especially developed for pero on an ikat telia rumal with a twist. This combination of classic ikat patterns from ancient textiles to a new medium, incorporate an earthy texture in the Grey Telia Rumal collection and a contrast Blue Telia Rumal, creating a seamless pattern for different interior spaces.
